FEES DUE

- BASC membership is from March 2025 to March 2026.
- Installments can be arranged and are to be advised at the time of joining/renewing. For renewing members paying for a full year, the first installment must be paid by 1 March and the final payment due no later than 1 October.

BASC Membership Fee included:

- Payable by all members

PNGSI Fees and Insurance included:

- Payable by all swimmers - all swimmers must be affiliated with PNG Swimming Inc. (PNGSI)
- PNGSI arranges insurance for BASC members while at Taurama Aquatic and Indoor Centre (TAIC)
- At least 1 parent of swimmers under 18 years must be insured. All siblings of swimmers who ever attend the pool area must be insured and listed. It is recommended to have any parents, guardians or carers who will be attending the pool on a regular basis for the swimmer's training or club meets/competition to be listed and paid for.

The Pool Fee included:

- Payable by onshore members

Coaching Fee included:

- All swimmers training in a swim squad must pay this fee.

POOL ENTRY POLICY

The following policy outlines the requirements for BASC Members to enter the Taurama Aquatic and Indoor Centre free of charge or discounted as part of the lease agreement between TAIC and BASC:

Free Entry for Swimming Training:

BASC Members will receive free entry to the venue to attend and complete training sessions. All Members must adhere to the following rules in order to gain free entry:

1. Free entry for training will only be granted for the following times:
3:00pm - 5:30pm Monday to Friday
7:30am - 9:30am Saturday
2. Every Member must display their BASC Membership card to qualify for free entry
3. TAIC reserves the right to ask names and cross check with our Member list
4. Giving non-Members access to the pool using your family Membership card will result in disciplinary action, including removal of your privilege to free and discounted entry
5. All Members who enter free of charge are only permitted to swim with the squad and during the allocated times. Members wishing to swim before or after squad will need to pay the K5 discounted entry fee for use of the venue outside the above times
6. Parents/Guardians who are Members will receive free access to the venue only during the times mentioned above
7. Comply with Taurama Aquatic and Indoor Centre rules and regulations

Discounted Entry and Entry to Swim Carnivals:

All Members will receive discounted entry fee for use of the venue outside training times and for carnivals operated by BASC (club meets etc.). The discounted entry is set by TAIC and may change from time to time without notice. To gain discounted entry:

1. Members can enter at any time the venue is open under the discounted agreement
2. Members must display their BASC Membership card to qualify for discounted entry
3. TAC reserves the right to ask names and cross check with our Member list
4. Giving non-Members access to the pool using your family Membership card will result in disciplinary action, including removal of your privilege to free and discounted entry
5. Comply with Taurama Aquatic and Indoor Centre rules and regulations

Squads	Description
Aqua Kiddies	Learn to Swim - up to 2 sessions per week, 30 to 45 min sessions
Junior Squad	Beginner squad training & is intended as the transition from Aqua Kiddies to Squad swimming. At this level, the squad focuses on developing stroke technique & skills, while also introducing small amounts of endurance. 3 days per week - 1 hour sessions
Bronze Squad	4 sessions per week, 1hr15min sessions
Silver Squad	Recommended 5 to 6 sessions per week, 1hr30min sessions
Gold Squad	Recommended 6 to 8 sessions per week, 1hr30min to 2hr sessions
